Are you an experienced SAP Systems Analyst / UX Developer? Do you have experience in developing excellent visual designs with intuitive user experience for complex web applications? Would you like to join IT during an exciting and challenging period of growth in project delivery?

We are looking for an experienced SAP Systems Analyst / UX Developer to join the KRISTAL Project Team to further develop an existing bespoke application that costs and manages the financial aspects of University research projects. This solution is based on SAP technologies and integrates into core functionality in SAP Grants Management, Project System and Financial Accounting and accessed via the SAP Portal. You will be involved in gathering and articulating the project requirements, as well as taking forward these requirements to deliver intuitive solutions in accordance with the system design.

With experience in effectively eliciting requirements, documenting processes and requirements and providing solutions supported by your effective communication skills. You will be well organised and have the ability to prioritise your work effectively to ensure that deadlines are met. You will be experienced in providing specialist advice and guidance, influencing and negotiating with the business to ensure that this bespoke solution is fit for their needs.

What does the role entail?

As a SAP Systems Analyst / UX Developer, your main duties will include:

- Using SAP Web/development technologies to deliver intuitive solutions in accordance with best practice in system design;
- Using ABAP workbench/object navigator and related functionality to create developments, enhancements, modifications and interfaces in line with user requirements for the research community;
- Developing and maintaining an in depth understanding of the University's research business processes and systems;



- Working collaboratively with key stakeholders including Business Owners, Users and Business Analysts from within IT and the wider University to gather and elicit requirements, to support design and delivery of functionality for the Phase 2 of the KRISTAL project;
- Leading on solution design and development as well as producing functional specifications, for example, new screens, reports or programs, in line with user requirements for the research community;
- Working with the Testing Team to produce testing strategies, systems test
 plans and carry out system testing and integration testing of developed
 functionality prior to user acceptance testing;
- Documenting updates to data dictionary and ensuring new data elements clearly defined.

These duties provide a framework for the role and should not be regarded as a definitive list. Other reasonable duties may be required consistent with the grade of the post.

What will you bring to the role?

As a SAP Systems Analyst / UX Developer you will have:

- Experience of developing SAP BSP applications using HTML, CSS, and JavaScript, and /or experience of SAP ABAP programming language
- Experience in testing, performance tuning, and debugging SAP / other web applications;
- The ability to work independently as well as part of a team to ensure the business requirements are transformed into quality solutions;
- Experience of acting as the IT lead in delivering project work streams;
- The ability to lead workshops with Business experts to verify requirements and design and discuss implementation plans;
- Experience of delivering solutions for strategic projects using a structured project management lifecycle;
- Excellent communication and influencing skills, including experience of effectively engaging with a wide range of stakeholders;



- Experience of effectively analysing complex problems and data, presenting solutions and information in a meaningful way to diverse range of audiences;
- Experience of working to deadlines, prioritising a range of tasks to ensure delivery in a role which made competing demands on your time.

You may also have:

- SAP development experience utilizing SAP UI5 and the new SAP Web IDE (HAT desirable) and Portal Content Management;
- Knowledge of Waterfall/Agile development methodologies;
- Experience of training key users in new solutions.
